The 2018 Mokuhanga Basic Training Program C Guidelines

Sunday, September 2 – Saturday, October 6, 2018

1. INTRODUCTION

The MI-LAB Committee invites artists who want to learn Japanese water-based woodblock printmaking (mokuhanga) basic skills. Artists learn mokuhanga under Japanese teachers and make prints, living at Lake Kawaguchi residence for 35 days (including your arrival date in Tokyo). This is a self-support pay program. The artists need to finance themselves to participate in this program.

*Note: Hereinafter, Mokuhanga Innovation Laboratory will be referred to as 'THE ORGANIZER', and this basic program itself as 'THE PROGRAM'.

2. PROGRAM NAME

MI-LAB Lake Kawaguchi Artist-in-Residence: the 2018 Mokuhanga Basic Training Program C.

3. PERIOD OF THE PROGRAM

Sunday, September 2 – Saturday, October 6, 2018

4. NUMBER OF ARTISTS

Six (6) artists of which 1 artist will be defined in the present selection

5. PROGRAM FEE

Artists in this program pay ¥313,891 (including consumption tax fee + PayPal handling fee) to the MI-LAB Committee. ¥89,683 must be paid at the time of the contract by as the registration fee to the Committee. The remaining ¥224,208 will be charged prior to your arrival at the Lake Kawaguchi Residence by cash.

- The participation fee will cover the following costs:

1. Lodging	A private room (Japanese tatami room) Kitchen and bathroom will be shared with the other artists.
2. Studio	A large 100 meters-squared shared studio (Japanese tatami room)
3. Schedule	1 st week: orientation, material, tool study 2 nd week: technical study 3 rd and 4 th week: self-study and tools maintenance
4. Materials	Woodblocks, paper, watercolor ink and basic material will be provided as necessary for production during the program. Additional costs will be charged for the use of extra materials.
5. Tools	Japanese carving knives, printing brushes and baren will be provided as tools to be able to bring back to home after the program. Additional costs will be charged to order extra tools. Please inform us if you already have your own tools.
6. Miscellaneous	Upon request, English-speaking staff will assist you to make living in Fuji-Kawaguchiko easy and comfortable.

6. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the program, applicants must:

1. Be an artist or a print teacher.
2. Preferably be 30 to 50 years of age.
3. Be in good health and have this fact attested to by a doctor.
4. Understand English or Japanese at a level that allows meaningful participation in the printmaking training program.
5. Raise funds for their necessary costs by themselves.
6. Be eager to communicate in good spirit with other invited artists and local people and to contribute to mutual understanding and goodwill between Japan and other countries of the world.
7. Be willing to follow the activities schedule and residential arrangements as planned by the MI-LAB.

Experience with woodblock printmaking: While applications will be accepted from artists at all levels of experience with woodblock printmaking, it is important to keep in mind that the program consists of *fundamental training in mokuhanga (water-based woodblock printmaking)*. For this reason, it may not prove satisfactory to artists who have had extensive experience in this field.

7. APPLICATION DEADLINE:

Applications must be received by **Sunday, July 15, 2018** (Japanese time).
