ANNEX 1 (reference): About paper and woodblocks to be used for the Thematical Programs:

• Washi:

Participants are requested to purchase and use Japanese paper made in Echizen for these Programs. The organizer will select several kinds of Echizen paper suitable for Mokuhanga in consultation with instructors and papermakers and introduce them to you at the beginning and in the course of the Program. In addition, you may visit some paper mills and shops and purchase washi during the residency.

## • Woodblocks:

We use shina plywood as woodblocks. The maximus size is 90 cm imes 60 cm.

Please inform the organizer what size and how many blocks you need when we ask you in advance.

You don't need to pay for the woodblocks you ordered in advance.

\*Please note that some sizes of blocks might be offered only in a limited quantity due to the shortage of imported shina timbers.

\*You may purchase additional blocks during the residency if it is needed. In this case you will be asked to pay for them.

• Tools and materials:

Please bring your carving and printing tools with you. You may use those of the Studio, but please note that they are for common use. Their conditions might not be good enough for your work.
