## Attachment No.1 Description about MI-LAB Echizen Studio



Name of the facility: MI-LAB Echizen Studio

Address: 27-8 Awatabe Town, Echizen City, Fukui Prefecture

We use a traditional Japanese style two-floor residence house as a studio and office. Please understand that there are some peculiarities due to the nature of the building before applying for a MI-LAB AIR program.

### 1. Studio

There is a large shared studio with six workbenches. If the studio isn't large enough for all the participants, the next room can be also used as an additional studio.



The room next to the studio used to be “kura” (traditional Japanese warehouses). We usually use it as a classroom for group tuitions.

### 2. Private rooms

Each artist will be provided with one room which is in the traditional Japanese style. The partitions between the rooms are panel sliding doors which are fixed so that they cannot be opened. There are also “*ranma*” (small open windows for ventilation with decorative carvings) over the doors. We have decided to preserve them so as not to spoil the beauty of the house, though the privacy level is not as high as usual hotel rooms. Please understand this point before using.

Each room is equipped with:

- a bed;
- a ceiling light and a table light;
- an air conditioner;
- a PC table and a chair;
- hangers and shelves.



### 3. Dining room

There is a large shared dining room with kitchen facilities. Participants can cook and eat here. It can also be used as a living room during breaks.



### 4. Bath and toilet

There are one bathroom with a shower and two toilets on the first floor, and one toilet on the second floor.

We do not put water in the bath tub.

Participants are requested to use the shower in turn.

### 5. Others

There is an elevator, a laundry with a washing machine and a dryer for common use.

There is a Japanese garden with pine trees.

The architecture is very beautiful with an atrium, and wooden pillars can be seen here and there.
